SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

Dear Parent/Guardian,

Thank you for your interest in applying for a scholarship for your child at Heritage College.

This document explains the scholarships available at Heritage College in 2020 for Secondary students. Please read the important information below, which will assist you in the application process.

Heritage College believes in the development of the individual in all facets of human endeavour; academic, spiritual, emotional, physical and social. These characteristics are best developed in a Christ-centred, serving and caring environment. We wish to encourage students in developing these essential characteristics, and attract students who will strengthen our College culture in this direction.

There is currently one category of scholarships offered at Heritage College, with a second being developed:

Category A – Secondary Leadership Scholarships

These scholarships are based on the individual qualities of the student and available to new students at Heritage College for 2020

The scholarships will be given to students who show leadership potential in any of the following areas:

Community Service

Drama

Academic ability

Visual Arts

Musical Performance

Public Speaking

Peer Support

All students that apply for a scholarship must have a commendable behaviour reference and show a grade average of greater than 'C'. Those applying on academic ability must show a high level of achievement in three or more subjects.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. Are there any conditions attached to the Scholarships?

Yes. Scholarships are subject to continued satisfactory academic performance, behaviour, participation and attitude. These elements are taken into account in a twice-yearly review.

2. How much do these Scholarships cover?

a. Secondary Leadership Scholarships represent a 50% discount on tuition fees per year for two years.

(Please note that successful scholarship recipients are not entitled to any further fee discounts)

3. Late Payment of Fees?

Parents/Guardians are still responsible for a portion of the fees when students are on scholarship programs. Fees require payment according to the normal payment schedule. Late payment of this portion may result in the College revoking the scholarship.

4. How do we apply?

- a. Read the Scholarship Guidelines carefully.
- b. Fill out the application form appropriate to your child's entry level.
- c. Attach all relevant documents.
- d. Send the completed form and attachments to arrive by 30th June 2019.

5. Other Tuition?

Please note that these scholarships are purely financial. They do not entitle the student to any extra tutoring or differing academic program. However, due to the dedicated staff, smaller class sizes and our Student Support Program, parents can be guaranteed of appropriate academic support for their student.

6. Success of your application?

Please note that there is no guarantee your application will be successful. Each application is assessed on an individual basis, and students are accepted at the discretion of the Leadership Team. However, we do have a generous number of scholarships for 2020 and encourage you to apply soon.

7. What are the Criteria?

The application form is a part of the assessment criteria. Complete all sections of the application form to ensure eligibility. Students will be assessed on information given in all sections of the application form, including references, academic records, and response to questions.

8. Is there a cut off date for applications?

Yes. These scholarships are for study for 2020 and 2021. Hence, it is necessary to act quickly if you want to be considered for a Scholarship. Applications close on 30th June 2019.

9. When will we be notified of the result of our application?

Notice will be given by letter as to whether your application has been successful or unsuccessful. Notifications will be made by the end of October 2019.
